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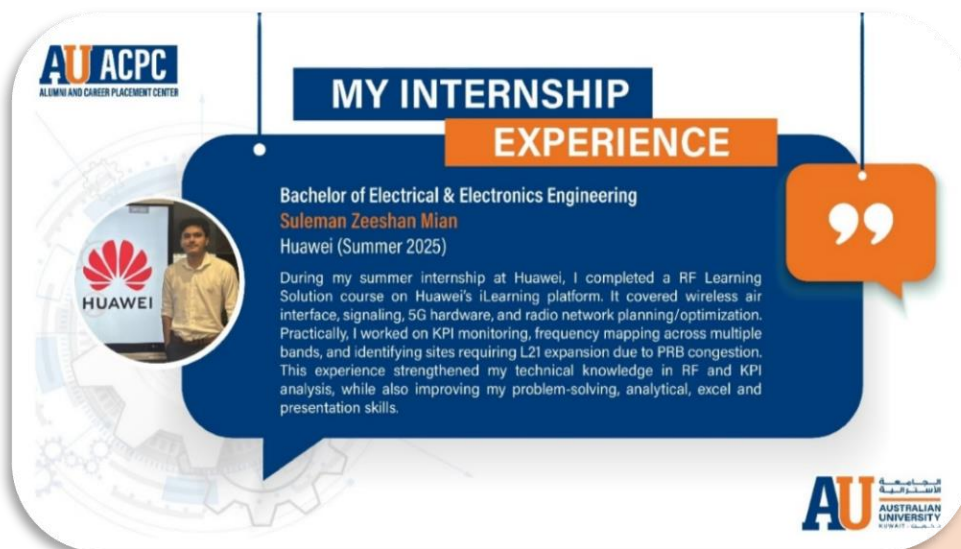
MY INTERNSHIP EXPERIENCE

During my summer internship at Huawei, I completed a RF Learning Solution course on Huawei's iLearning platform. It covered wireless air interface, signaling, 5G hardware, and radio network planning/optimization. Practically, I worked on KPI monitoring, frequency mapping across multiple bands, and identifying sites requiring L21 expansion due to PRB congestion. This experience strengthened my technical knowledge in RF and KPI analysis, while also improving my problem-solving, analytical, excel and presentation skills.

INSIGHTS FROM INDUSTRY: LEARNING BEYOND THE CLASSROOM

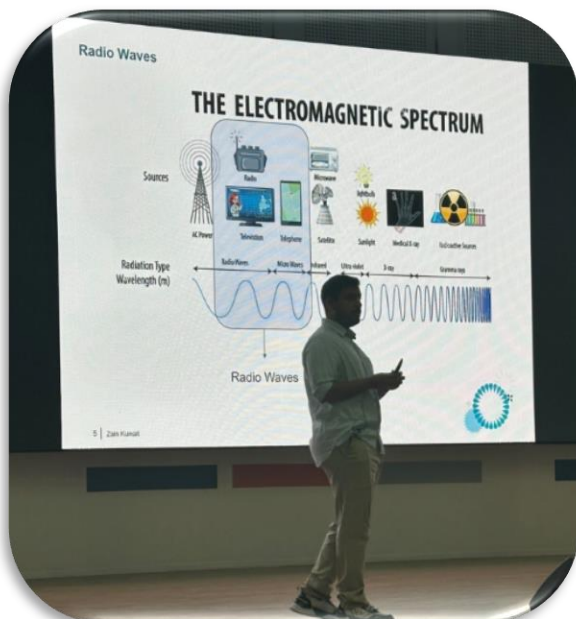
ACPC successfully coordinated three guest speaker sessions, where industry professionals highlighted classroom concepts with real-world experiences, providing students with practical insights and career guidance.
